

Launching Leaders in the Arts – Student Art Criteria 2024

Each student may submit only one work of art. The work must be the ORIGINAL work of the student and have been completed within the past year.

All Applicants must submit a digital photo of their art.

Submit digital image of your art: Each image should be a jpg 1200-1500 pixels on the long side @ 72 ppi, with a file size less than 2 Mb. Format accepted - .gif, .jpg, .png.

Please title your work: first name, last name, 'Artwork Title', School, Size

Medium (oil, watercolor, acrylic, photography, sculpture, etc.)

For Digital Art entries – No AI generative or prompt engineering AI will be accepted. Please describe your process for digital art.

Rules for ART application

- Minimum size should be: 11 x 14 or 12 x 12 or larger, mounted, matted.
- All art should have name, title, school, contact information on top right back corner for hanging art, or tagged for ceramic, sculptural art
- All art should be exhibition ready for display
- Please review protocol for jurors' selection– attached
- Picture frame wire should not be above the frame. Picture frame wire is a multi-strand wire. Do not use monofilament. No sawtooth hangers.
- Screw eyes/D-rings and hanging wire MUST be attached firmly to the back of the piece with screws. Works on canvas must be framed or have finished edges.
- Gallery wrapped canvas is acceptable, provided that no staples are showing, and the edges are clean and free of smudges and smears that are not in keeping with the stylistic intent of the artwork.

Deadline for online entries is Sunday, March 3, 2024. Judging will be conducted on Saturday, March 9, 2024.

All judging will be conducted in person. Please bring your completed art to the Jack J Geldbart Selby Library Auditorium 1:30 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. Present your art at that time for judging; return at 3:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. to pick up your art.

Selected award recipients are invited to an Awards luncheon on Wednesday, April 10th, 2024, at Bird Key Yacht Club. Framed art must accompany the artist for exhibition viewing.
